



## Figurative System of Human Knowledge

edited by Denis Diderot and Jean le Rond d'Alembert

Diderot and d'Alembert, French Enlightenment intellectuals, wrote and published the first Encyclopedia. It was a book containing knowledge of all subjects that would be constantly updated with learning in all subjects from many countries. This page shows an image ("figure") of their theory about what the concept of knowledge meant in all its abundant forms. Like a "taxonomy" in science, the diagram below sets out to sort all types of knowledge into progressively more detailed groups and classifications.
